Phase 1: Month 5

- Integration of services related to Blue Zones Initiative
- Developing Blue Zone Champions of at least 50 across several platforms
- Physical location for the Wellness Center with "Health Under One Roof" concept
- Anticipated co-location of Blue Zone Team at Wellness Center

Community Engagement

- Engaged with FRHD youth group to expand Blue Zone outreach strategy
- Provided training opportunities to staff regarding T.I.E.R.S framework with a plan to fully engage FRHD community in the next 30-90 days. Integration of social media, cross-promotional efforts, and advertisements
