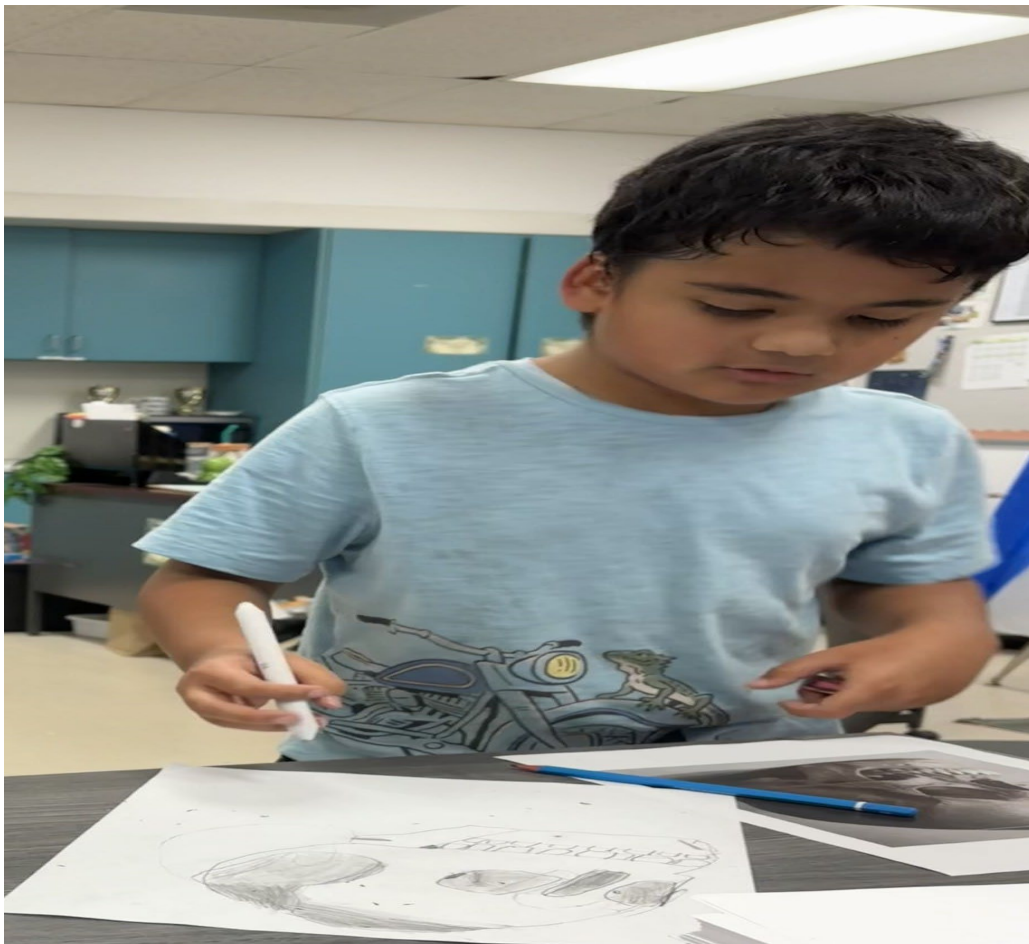

Aldo has been a member of the Boys & Girls Clubs of North County since he started school, and until this year he has been struggling with challenging behaviors. Activities and programs for his age group did not hold his interest, so he was prone to mischief, and his behavior was dismissed as disruptive. This year, an art program started at his site, and the instructor modified the activities to accommodate all ages and abilities. This allowed the youth more freedom of self-expression and exploration, which Aldo had been craving. His disruptive behaviors decreased dramatically during Art Club, and his strong will was a strength instead of a challenge. He threw himself into the lessons, and he was especially inspired by the charcoal shading and blending lesson. After learning about charcoal, he dedicated so much of his free time to practicing the techniques taught to him in Art Club that the instructor gave him his own soft pencil and blending tool to take him. By March, he earned a spotlight as one of three featured artists in the annual art showcase. He is going to be nominated for Artist of the Year at the annual awards ceremony, and his friends and staff are so excited that he found a passion to channel all his extra energy and curiosity. The Boys & Girls Club appreciates his innate talent and is so proud of his growth this year.
